Credo *(Nicene Creed)*



This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

C Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

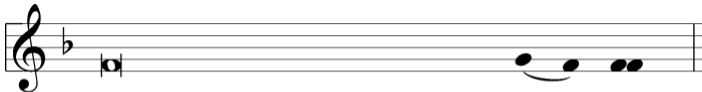

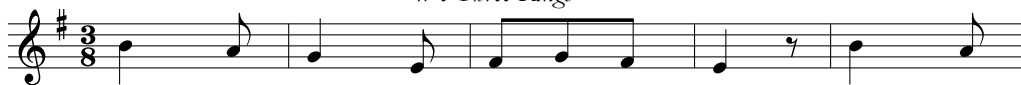
